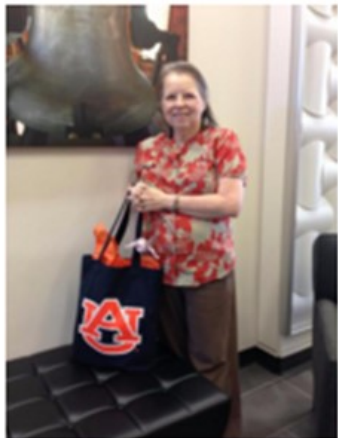


Campaign Update

Agency Spotlight: Unity Wellness Center



United Way of Lee County, Inc.

Unity Wellness Center works to provide services for individuals or families infected or affected by HIV, advocate on behalf of those who are HIV-positive or living with AIDS, as well as conduct outreach and education efforts in the local community. These services include: case management, transportation, counseling, testing, HIV prevention education and housing financial assistance for those infected or affected by HIV/AIDS living in Lee, Macon, Russell, Chambers, and Tallapoosa Counties.

Along with these services, Unity Wellness provides other programs to help those living with HIV/AIDS. The Housing Opportunities for People with Aids or HOPWA provides rental assistance that can be accessed for up to 4 months in a 12 month period. Link + Care is a program dedicated to linking HIV positive individuals to medical care that connects patients with a coordinator to overcome any barriers they may face when accessing medical care. Along with these services, multiple education and prevention programs are set up to reach Lee County and surrounding communities. An example is "Being a Responsible Teen", a program for high-risk youth, designed to promote responsible behaviors among students. BART includes basic HIV knowledge, healthy relationship skills and tips on countering peer pressure.

December 1st, marked World AIDS Day, a time for people worldwide to unite in the fight against HIV and show support for people living with HIV. Take this month to educate yourself on the facts of HIV and AIDS all over the world and in our local community of Lee County.
