They enrolled him in an EAMHC program to understand how his history of abuse and neglect impacted his development. Jordan was later diagnosed with autism spectrum disorder and symptoms of ADHD.



With medication and therapy, Jordan's parents noted increased imaginative play and improved mood stability. EAMHC supported his transition to kindergarten, fostering independence and school engagement. Today, Jordan is a kind, thriving, and helpful friend, thanks to EAMHC's ongoing care coordination.
