United Way Student Health Fund is a program that can help pay for medical or dental needs of uninsured students enrolled in Auburn City Schools, Lee County Schools or Opelika City Schools. Routine cleanings and physicals are not eligible to receive funds and UWLC must receive a referral from the school system or DHR. This year, we provided a grant to support the mental health coordinators in Auburn City Schools, Lee County Schools, and Opelika City Schools.
